## ROSSO DI MONTALCINO DOC 2010

*This wine was originally known as the Biondi-Santi "White Label Brunello", but changed its name in 1983, when the Rosso di Montalcino DOC was established. It reflects the signature style of our high-altitude vineyards with a vibrant freshness and a distinct fruitiness which makes it thoroughly enjoyable at a young age.*

### VINTAGE 2010

*A truly exceptional vintage. June was rainy on average and was followed by a dry July. Light showers occurred in August, followed by a warm and dry harvest season. Picking started on September 19th.*

### ORIGIN

*The Rosso di Montalcino 2010 was produced with our proprietary clone of Sangiovese Grosso called BBS<sub>11</sub> (Brunello Biondi Santi 11), which was identified and selected by Biondi-Santi at Tenuta Greppo in the Seventies. For this wine we exclusively used grapes from the youngest vines with less than 10 years of age.*

### AGEING

*The 2010 Rosso di Montalcino was aged in Slavonian oak barrels for 12 months.*
