## ROSSO DI MONTALCINO DOC 1989

### Fascia Rossa

*This wine was originally known as the Biondi-Santi "White Label Brunello", but changed its name in 1983, when the Rosso di Montalcino DOC was established. It reflects the signature style of our high-altitude vineyards with a vibrant freshness and a distinct fruitiness which makes it thoroughly enjoyable at a young age.*

#### VINTAGE 1989

*A medium quality vintage. A very dry and hot spring followed by a summer with several precipitations. Grapes resulted rich in water but healthy and rich in colour.*

#### ORIGIN

*The Rosso di Montalcino 1989 Fascia Rossa was produced with our proprietary clone of Sangiovese Grosso called BBS11 (Brunello Biondi Santi 11), which was identified and selected by Biondi-Santi at Tenuta Greppo in the Seventies. For this wine we used grapes from vineyards which were older than 4 years of age, including the oldest ones that are usually designated for the production of both Brunello and Riserva.*

#### AGEING

*The 1989 Rosso di Montalcino Fascia Rossa was aged in Slavonian oak barrels for 12 months.*
